I am a registered Navajo voter. Under the initiative power reserved to the People, I respectfully request the following, **in writing**:

1. The current requirements for placing a citizen initiative on the ballot, including the required number or percentage of registered voters' signatures, the petition format, and the filing procedure;
2. The citation to the current controlling law for each requirement (Title 11 section numbers and any amending resolutions, by number and date);
3. A copy of, or reference to where the public may read, the current text of those provisions.

I make this request because Title 11 of the Navajo Nation Code does not appear in the published Code, and I have been unable to locate the current requirements in any public source. Your written answer will be, to my knowledge, the first publicly available statement of these requirements.
